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FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Welcome to our office! In order to assure that you understand all of the charges pertaining to your prenatal care and delivery, our office has prepared the following information. If you have any further questions, please ask one of us. This information serves as an estimate for your planning purposes. Please understand that these charges are subject to change as overall changes occur in the health industry.

FIRST OB VISIT: **\$650.00**

Includes a complete history, physical exam, and education material.

ULTRASOUND AT FIRST OB VISIT: **\$525.00**

Each visit after the initial exam will be **\$230.00**. The number of visits depends on when you enter our system. For example, if you are low risk, you may expect a total of 11-13 visits in our office, if we first see you at 8-10 weeks.

Typically, an ultrasound is ordered outside of the office mid pregnancy. The cost of the ultrasound is approximately **\$715.00**

DELIVERY FEE (includes 6-week postpartum visit)*

Vaginal Delivery	\$4650.00
Cesarean Delivery	\$5500.00
VBAC (vaginal birth after cesarean)	\$5600.00
Cesarean following attempted Trial Of Labor After Cesarean "TOLAC"	\$6275.00

Your portion of the delivery fee is expected to be paid by the seventh month (28-32wks) of your pregnancy.

*If you schedule your 6-week follow-up check after 12 weeks, you will be charged for the exam.

Please note that our office will bill your insurance company as a courtesy to you, but we ask that if your deductible has been met, you pay your co-payment for each visit at the time you are seen, or the full amount should be paid at your appointments if your deductible has **NOT** been met. We are Blue Cross and Aetna providers and accept many other insurance plans, including Medicaid and Denali Kid Care.

LABORATORY TEST

INITIAL BLOOD WORK:

Rubella screening
Blood typing/RH factor
Antibody screening
Hepatitis B
Complete Blood Counts
RPR-Syphilis screen
Urinalysis and urine culture
Chlamydia/Gonorrhea test
HIV

SEVENTH MONTH BLOOD WORK:

Screening for **gestational diabetes** and **anemia**

If you are RH negative, you will need additional blood test drawn at 28 weeks and a Rhogam injection. The cost of the injection is approximately **\$320.00**.

At 37 weeks a vaginal/rectal culture will be done for a Group B strep, and if indicated a test for anemia.

The laboratory will bill you separately for any lab work the provider may order. The lab will accept insurance including Medicaid and Denali Kid Care.
